MASTER DAVID KOH 58, is a practitioner, teacher and researcher of the ancient Chinese science of Feng Shui or Geomancy with over 38 years of experience in practising and teaching the subject. In 1998, David founded the Malaysian Institute of Geomancy Sciences (MINGS), and served as its President for two terms and is currently the Honorary Life President.

Fifteen years ago, David formulated a scientific system of Feng Shui calibration, the '4 step method' – Identification, Selection, Matching and Igniting. David has also translated the I-Ching Trigrams and Hexagrams into Binary language, using the famous '0' and '1'. Over the years, he has conducted numerous talks and has written articles on various aspects of Feng Shui for the local newspaper, attend to television and radio channels invitation and contributed articles to many journals including the monthly journal of the Malaysian Institute of Architects, conducted research, seminars and workshops.
